In the past I have heard Members and Visitors complain about the planes flying over our greens.

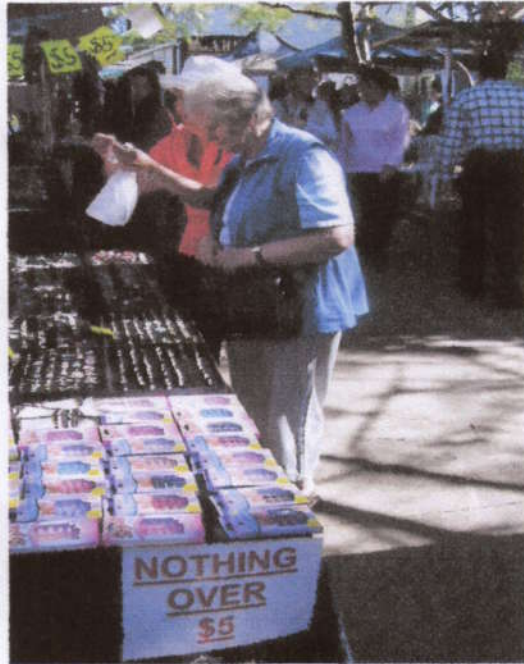
Have a look at this photograph and see what the Bowlers at Tugun Bowling Club have to put up with. Their Club is in the direct flight path of Coolangatta Airport.

The large, tank at the rear of the Club is now functioning and we have our own water supply which will be an easing on the funds of the Club. The Tank as you can see does not have unsightly pipes running from the roof or pipes running up and down walls.
